HIE Readiness	
Can your EHR act as a document consumer and query for and retrieve documents from external sources?

Is your organization currently exchanging data with Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) including lab, immunization registry, cancer registry, and/or syndromic surveillance? If so, what data formats are used?

Are you part of a regional health organization (RHO), regional care organization (RCO), or regional health information exchange (RHIE)?
